6. Go to the bank and pay your application fees using your created Student ID reference number(10000 FRW for Rwandan and EAC candidates and 12000FRW for International Student)

Documents Required for Application:

1. A cover letter indicating for which program of study the application is being made and description of the motivation to join the program
2. Detailed curriculum vitae
3. Notarized degree or equivalent from HEC
4. Notarized academic transcripts
5. Proof of payment of the admission fee (10,000 FRW for Rwandan and EAC candidates and 12000 FRW for International Student non-refundable)
6. Two recommendation letters from academic referees who are knowledgeable about the applicant,
7. Copy of National identity card or Passport
8. PhD research proposal (Concept note) (for those who apply for PhD)
